

ORDER ON CROSS MOTIONS FOR  
SUMMARY JUDGMENT

THIS MATTER came before the undersigned Superior Court Judge in and for the county of New Hanover on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of March, 2022 on cross motions of the plaintiff and defendant New Hanover County School Board for summary judgment pursuant to Rule 56 of the North Carolina Rules of Civil Procedure. The plaintiff appeared pro se. The defendant New Hanover County School Board was represented by Maya H. Weinstein of Tharrington Smith, LLP of the Wake County Bar. The New Hanover County Sheriff's Office was represented by Sharon Huffman, County Attorney for New Hanover County. The parties submitted joint stipulations of fact and concede that there is no genuine issue of material fact. The Court having reviewed the joint stipulations of fact, the memoranda of law and having heard the arguments of the parties finds that the defendant is entitled to judgment as a matter of law.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that defendant's motion for summary judgment is granted and plaintiff's motion for summary judgment is denied. The plaintiff's claims are dismissed. Each party shall bear their own costs.
